- October 26, 2016 - Robert Morgan SHS (South Region)
- November 2, 2016 - ITech@ Thomas Edison Education Center (Central Region)

Debate Format:

- Student panels representing both Democrat and Republican Party nominees for U.S. President from each of the aforementioned SHS will respond to questions during a moderated debate. Audience members will have the opportunity to ask the students on the panels questions.
