The national 2018 Women's History Month theme is *"Nevertheless She Persisted: Women Who Fight All Forms of Discrimination Against Women."*
- With an emphasis on positive role models and women from all backgrounds, the celebration of Women's History Month provides schools with opportunities to highlight women who have made a positive difference in our community, nation, and world. Additionally, Florida State Statute 1003.42 requires the study of the contributions of women to the United States.
