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- The Department of Social Sciences, in cooperation with the University of Miami and WLRN Public Broadcasting, is offering an advanced weekend Holocaust Institute for language arts, life skills, and social studies teachers, as well as media specialists who are interested in participating in a forum on teaching the Holocaust.
