 - The dates of the institute are as follows:
 - In-person meetings: June 14, 15, 16, 17, and 19.
 - Hours of in-person meetings: 9:30 a.m.- 2:00 p.m. (with 30 minute lunch break- lunch not included).
 - At home preparation meetings: June 11 and 18.
 - Topics include: East Asian history, religion, international and political affairs, geography, literature, culture, and more.
 - Participants will receive the following:
 - Instruction by experts in the field of Asian studies;
 - 33 Master Plan Points;
 - An honorarium of up to \$400 upon completion (paid for by the Asian Studies Program); and
