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- The Division of Social Sciences and Life Skills is offering a one-day training for secondary social studies teachers from Differentiated Accountability Schools on Saturday, October 17, 2009 at the Historical Museum of Southern Florida (101 West Flagler Street) starting at 9:00 a.m. and ending at 3:30 p.m. The Historical Museum of Southern Florida is easily accessible via the Metrorail (exit at the government center) or participants can park at the Municipal Parking Garage located on the corner of N.W. Second Avenue and Flagler Street. **Parking is NOT free.**
  - During this workshop, participants will receive instruction on how to incorporate literacy skills through social studies content, how to use Power Writing in social studies, and how to use object-based learning as a critical thinking strategy while teaching social studies content. Participants will receive eight (8) Master Plan Points for attending the workshop and completing the following up activity.
