- The Department of Social Sciences' Financial Literacy instructional resources/lessons are designed to be utilized post-assessment season during the last 3 weeks of the academic year during Social Sciences' instructional time.
- To access the lessons, go to the Department of Social Sciences' website: <http://socialsciences.dadeschools.net>, and click on the Financial Literacy icon and then click on the appropriate grade level file of your interest.
- Each grade level (K-12) instructional resources consist of:
  - 15 stand-alone and comprehensive lesson plans with all necessary materials to deliver the lessons (e.g., handouts, graphic organizers, Power Point presentations, web-based and video links, etc.);
  - A curriculum guide/framework for each grade level is available and provides an overview of the 15 lessons and a guide to the 15 days of instruction. The framework provides an overview of the Financial Literacy content benchmarks and correlated literacy standards per day, lesson number, title, and description of each lesson, and a list of instructional tools necessary to deliver the lesson.
