- The Mock Trial District Competition will take place on February 23 and 24, 2012 at the Miami Conference Center, 400 SE 2nd Avenue, Miami, Florida.
 - Team members **must** be students enrolled in an elective law class during the 2011-2012 school year or schools must request special permission from the Division of Social Sciences and Life Skills to enter a team of students who are not currently enrolled in an elective law class. (Permission request should be emailed to rbrazofsky@dadeschools.net)
 - Each school has the option of fielding a team which may include two members who are not currently enrolled in an elective law class this year; however, these two students must have been enrolled in an elective law class the previous year and must still be enrolled in a Miami-Dade County Public Schools.
 - Senior High Schools may only register **one** team for the competition.
