 - Ending time: Concert ends at 1:00 p.m. (should have their transportation meet them at the Arsht/James L. Knight Concert Hall or South Dade Senior High at 1:00 p.m. to return to their schools)
 - **Bus transportation and funding are NOT provided and is the responsibility of each school to organize. The James L. Knight Concert Hall at the Arsht Center is easily accessible via the metro rail and people mover. South Dade Senior High School has been selected to accommodate schools in the deep southern portion of the county.**
