- The Consulate General of Spain in Miami and the Spain-Florida Foundation is sponsoring the Hispanic Heritage History Bee Contest for students in grades 4-12. The contest is being held as one of the many activities planned by the Spain-Florida Foundation to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the arrival of the Spaniards to Florida.
 - In order to participate in the annual Hispanic Heritage History Bee contest, schools must complete the attached application form and return it to rdiaz@spain-florida.org by **September 27, 2012**. On the application forms, schools must identify a teacher contact for the contest. The contact person will receive all future communication from the contest organizers.
 - The contest consists of two phases – a written qualifying exam and an oral competition. A multiple choice written test will be administered by each participating lead teacher on **October 5, 2012**. One winner will be selected per school to compete in an Oral Competition on **Saturday, October 20, 2012** at Florida Atlantic University.
