 - Schools are to be reminded that for the 2017-18 school year, the following sequence of courses is still required for grades 6-8 Middle School Social Sciences:
 - Grade 6: M/J U.S. History
 - Grade 7: M/J Civics
 - Grade 8: M/J U.S. History (2017-18 8th grade cohort completed M/J World History during the 2015-16 school year).
 - The sequence of courses outlined above will ensure successful transition to the desired course sequence as follows beginning in school year 2018-19.
 - Grade 6: M/J U.S. History
 - Grade 7: M/J Civics
 - Grade 8: M/J World History
