- The District Student Government Association, in cooperation with the Miami Heat, is having its annual Student Leadership Conference on April 15, 2009 from 3:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.
- The conference will be held at the American Airlines Arena in downtown Miami.
- The focus of the conference is: "Miami's Future Leaders- Giving Back to Your Community."
- The conference is scheduled as an after school activity and SGA will be featured as special guests at the Miami Heat game (Heat vs. Pistons) after the conference. This is The Heat's last regular season game of the year.
- Following is a tentative schedule for the conference:
 - 2:30 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. Schools Arrive
 - 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Student Leadership Conference
 - 6:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. Dinner
 - 8:00 – Heat vs. Pistons Game Begins
- Cost to attend the conference is \$20.00 per student. The fee includes the conference, dinner, and entrance into the Heat game.
- Schools must collect the money from the students and send a school check made payable to The Miami Heat and send the check to Bob Brazofsky, Supervisor, Curriculum and Instruction, Social Sciences, work location 9626 on or before Friday, March 20, 2009.
- In addition, schools wishing to attend the conference are asked to complete the attached registration form and send it via FAX to 305 995-1492.
- Game tickets will be distributed to schools at the Leadership Conference.
- Once schools have registered, additional information will be forwarded to participating schools accordingly.
- For every 10 students attending the conference, chaperons must pay \$10.00 which covers the cost of the conference, dinner, and the Heat game for the chaperons.
- Schools are asked to invite students who are rising leaders in their schools and are limited to 20 students per school.
- Attached to this briefing are: A Student Leadership Conference Summary Sheet, A Student Leadership Conference Registration Form, and The Miami Heat Flyer/Advertisement for the event.
- Participating schools are responsible for following the required field trip procedures at their school sites.
- Transportation to and from the conference is not provided.
