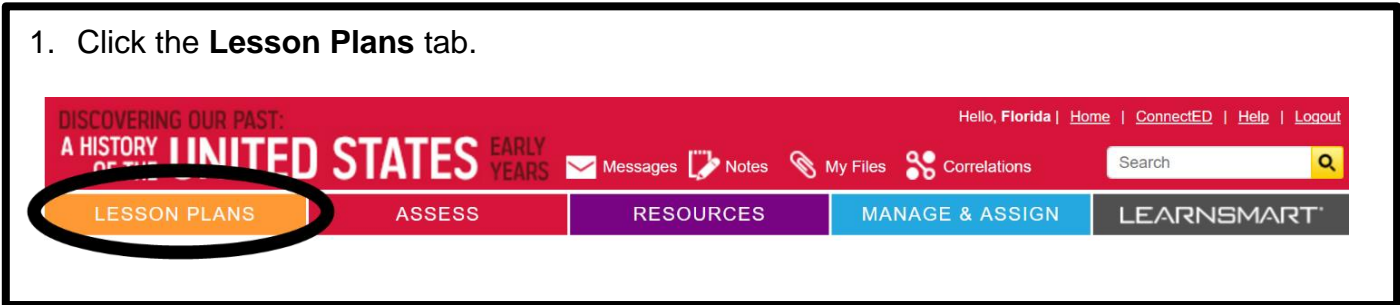


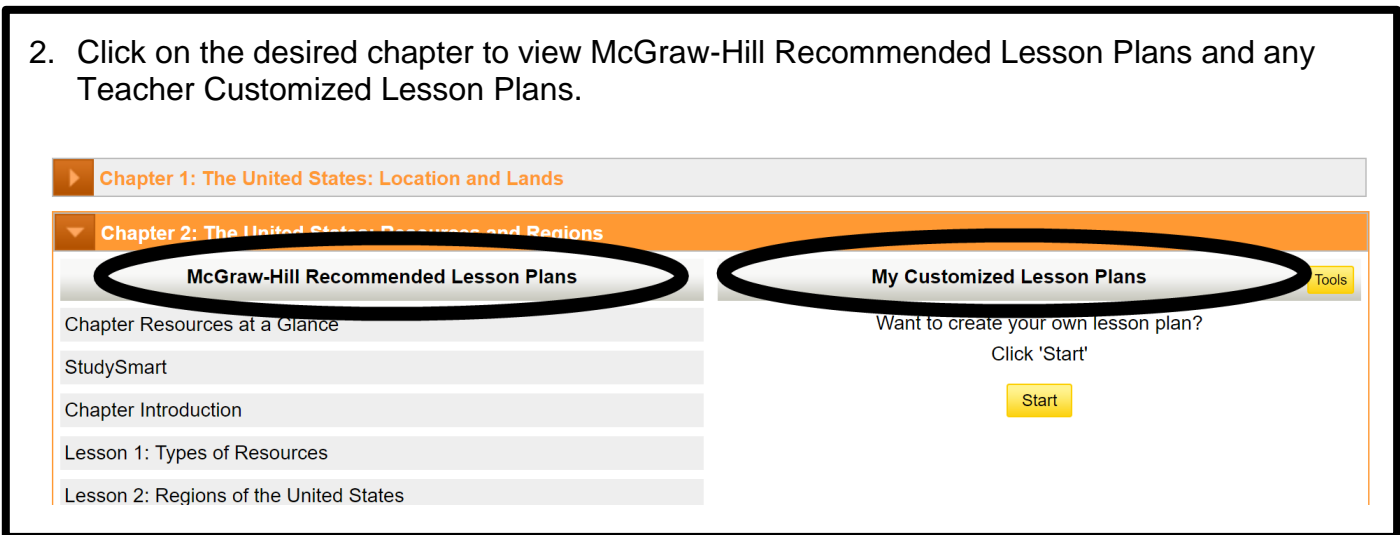
# 13. Editing Lesson Plans

This guide provides the steps for customizing McGraw-Hill lesson plans.

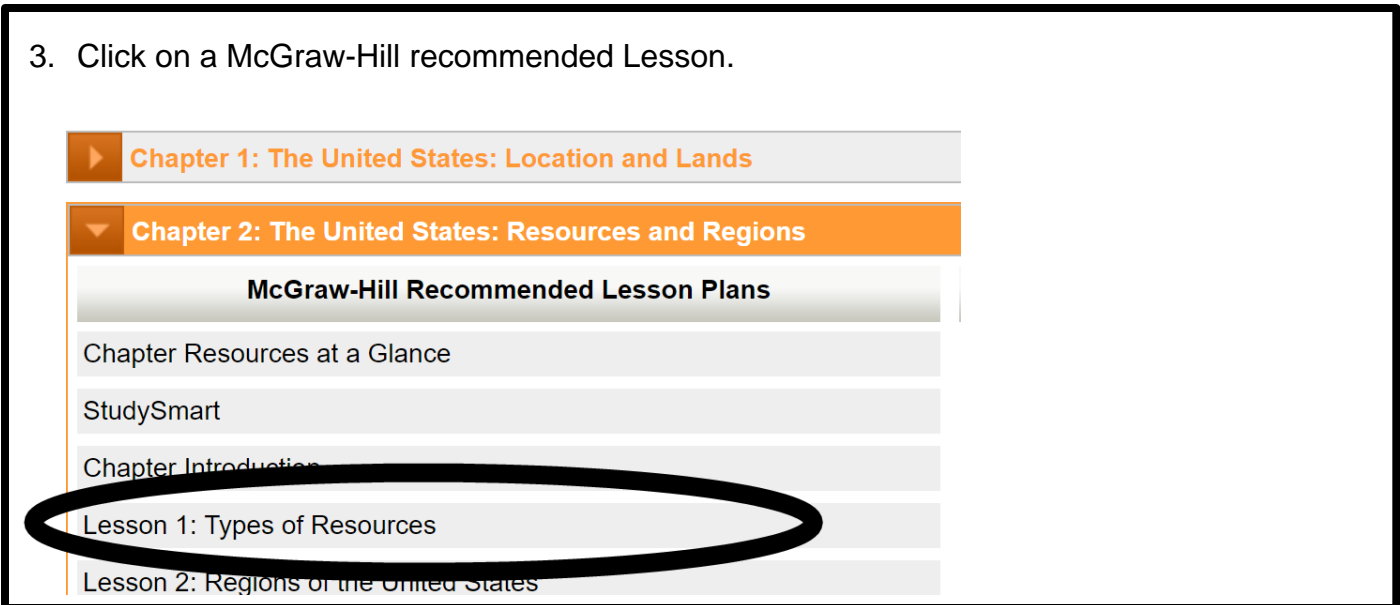
1. Click the **Lesson Plans** tab.
